
Walk to Isfield Lock and Weir

Walk to Isfield Lock and Weir

Approx 2hrs

- 1. Starting at the Laughing Fish Walk down Station Road to Isfield Sign/Isfield Farm Shop(300mm), cross the road and take the track to the left of the park
- 2. Continue down the lane to White Bridge and the river.
- 3. Cross over the bridge and take the stile on the right. Keeping parallel to the river on your righthand side continue through the fields until you come to the stile and lane (Dulles Lane)
- 4. Turn right onto the lane.
- 5. Continue on the track through the trees and up a slight incline.
- 6. The lane stopes at a no entry stile to Sutton Place. Take the righthand path before the stile down a steep incline (it maybe muddy)
- 7. Continue along the path, through trees, over a narrow wooden bridge until the trees begin to thin out.
- 8. The lock, which is slowly being renovated is on the righthand side.
- 9. Continue past the lock until you come to a stile
- 10. Climb over the stile and immediately climb another stile on the righthand side.
- 11. Go through the trees to see the weir.
- 12. Return from the weir the way you came past the lock and onto the lane.
- 13. Continue on Dulles Lane, past the stile in step 4. There is various track off this lane but they are private property so stay on the lane.
- 14. At the end of the lane is a large green gate with built in stile. Climb over this and walk pass the houses to the end of the lane to the road, Anchor Lane.
- 15. Turn left and follow the road towards the Anchor Pub.
- 16. Walk passed the pub on the left, go over the bridge and through the stile on the left.
- 17. Veer away from the river to the right
- 18. Walk up through the fields crossing a wooden bridge with gates, over stiles to the last field where there is a wire fence and saplings trees on your right.
- 19. At the end of the field go through the gate onto the road into Isfield and turn left.
- 20. Follow the road to the signal box and turn left into the village
