Walk by the river to the Anchor Inn and back to Isfield past the Boat House Farm



<u>RIVER WALK –</u> approx. 45 minutes (unless you stop for a pint at the Anchor inn)

NB: towards the end of this walk it may be a bit muddy. Alternatively turn around at the Anchor Inn and come back the way you came

- 1. Starting at the Laughing Fish, walk down Station Road to the Isfield Village Sign (300m) the road and take the track to the left of the park
- 2. Continue down the lane to White Bridge and the river.
- 3. Climb over the stile on the left just before the bridge
- 4. Keeping the river on the right continue through a number of fields until you get to a cast iron railway bridge pass under this and go through the stile
- 5. If you fancy a pint, continue through this field tracking the river to the Anchor Inn which is through a stile and on the right across a bridge. After refreshments return across the bridge into this last field
- 6. Head away from the river up through centre of the field with the disused railway on your left. Cross over a wooden bridge, keep walking straight. The final field is fenced on your right.
- 7. At the end of the field pass through the gate onto the road. Turn left and follow the road to up to the signal box, turn left into Station Road and you are back to where you started at The Laughing Fish Pub
