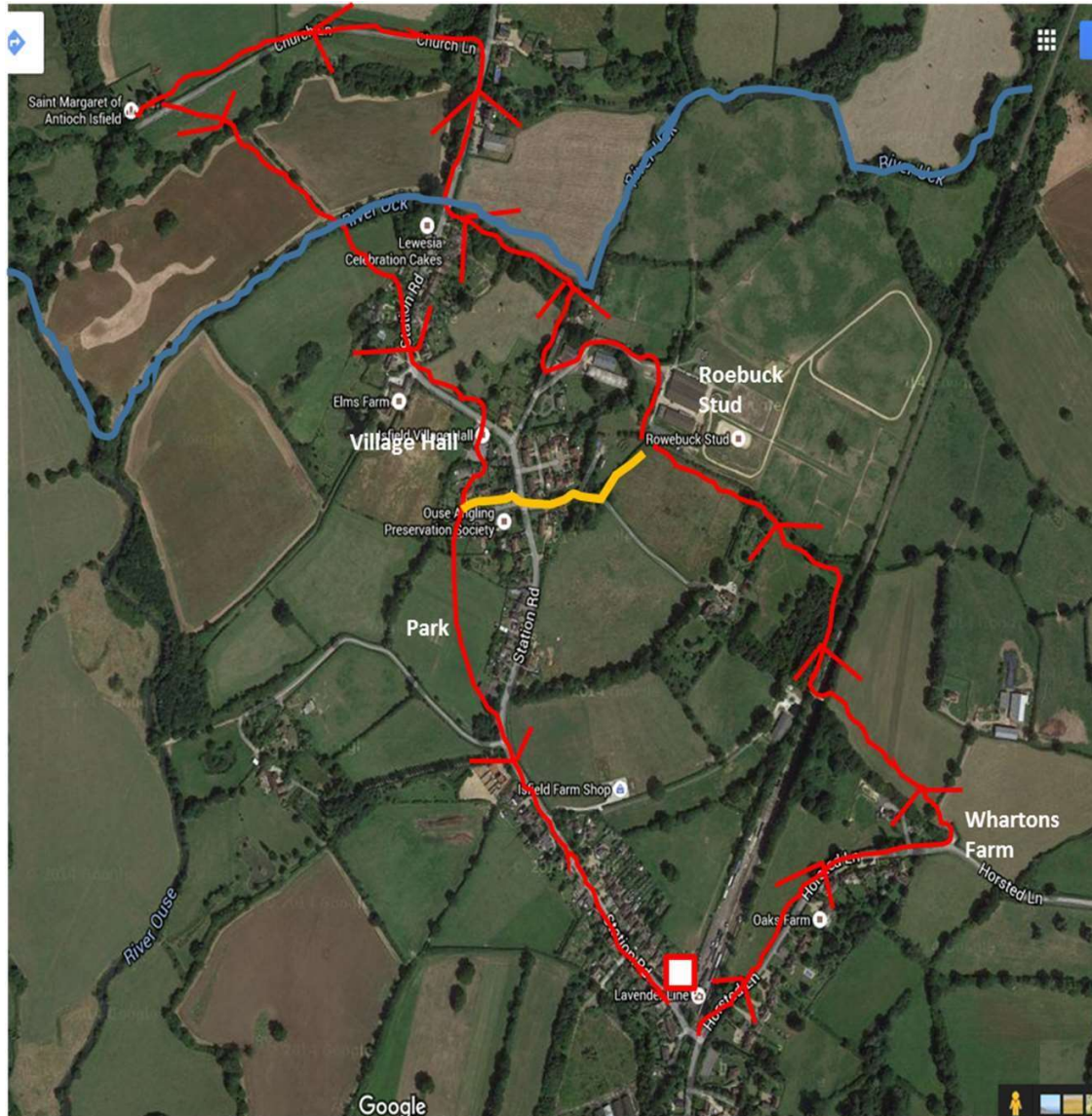


Circular walk around Isfield short (approx. 35min) or Long (approx. 1 hour)



1. Leave the pub turning left towards the railway
2. Go to the end of the road and turn left.
3. Follow the road past large houses until you reach a sharp righthand bend with entrance to Wharton's Farm on the left on the bend
4. Turn left along the track next to Wharton's Farm (on the right)
5. Cross the stile and walk across the field parallel to the lefthand fence.
6. Cross the stile and walk along the bridge over the railway line
7. Immediately after the bridge turn right and walk through to the kissing gate at the end (railway on the right)
8. Walk to the end of the trees turn immediately left. Walk ahead parallel to the hedge on the right and over the stile in the bottom right corner of the field.
9. Continue tracking the hedge on the right and fencing for horses on the left.

At the end of this field decide whether to go to the longer or shorter route.

Longer route (via Isfield Church) (Shown in Red)

10. At the end of the field turn right and walk through the farm yard, Roe Buck Stud – horse building on the right.
11. Follow the track to the end of the out building and turn immediately right behind the building. There should be a yellow footpath sign.
12. Cross the driveway, veer right and through a gate/stile. This can be a bit over grown, continue on the path adjacent to the river until you reach the road.
13. At the road turn right and walk approx. 200m and turn left into church lane
14. Walk down the lane to see the church.
15. Opposite the church go through the stile and walk straight across the field onto a wooden bridge
16. Walk across the next field parallel to the hedge on your left.
17. Cross a bridge and through the stile
18. Walk straight across the field heading to the houses and go through the stile
19. Walk down between the houses to the road.
20. Turn right and follow the road to the village Hall
21. Go through the car park, behind the village hall and exit onto a path at the far corner of the car park.
22. At the end of the path you are in Northfield Cottages – go diagonally right across the road to a path between 2 houses in the corner – this brings you into the park.
23. Walk towards the buildings in the park, go behind and exit the park
24. Cross over to the village sign, turn right and head for the pub.

Shorter route (Shown in Yellow)

10. At the end of the field turn left and continue to the end and go over the stiles.
11. Turn immediately right and continue down the lane to the road.
12. Cross over into Northfield Cottages and keep to the lefthand side walk down to the corner and turn left onto a path between 2 houses – this brings you into the park.
13. Walk towards the buildings in the park, go behind and exit the park
14. Cross over to the village sign, turn right and head for the pub.
